**ORDER**

This Criminal Petition has been filed seeking to quash the proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3 in C.C.No.2030 of 2025 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class (Excise) at Karimnagar.

2. Heard Mr.P.R.Bharath Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.Jithendar Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1.

3. Though the criminal petition was filed seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.2030 of 2025, during the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners restricted his prayer

requesting this Court to dispense with the appearance of the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3 in C.C.No.2030 of 2025, on the file of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class (Excise) at Karimnagar.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not opposed the submission made by the learned counsel for petitioners.

5. Taking into consideration the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case, the presence of petitioner Nos.2 and 3/accused Nos.2 and 3 before the Judicial Magistrate of First Class (Excise) at Karimnagar, in C.C.No.2030 of 2025 is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of petitioner Nos.2 and 3/accused Nos.2 and 3 is required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of their non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for their appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law. However, no such relief is granted against petitioner No.1/accused No.1.

6. Accordingly, the criminal petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

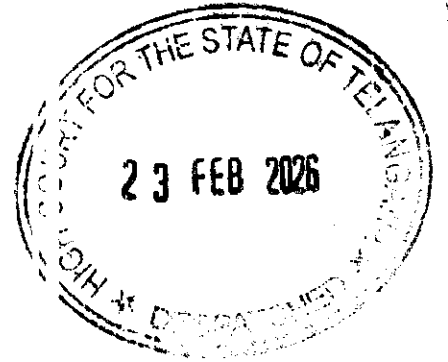
