**ORDER**

This Criminal Petition has been filed seeking to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.59 of 2025, on the file of the II Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-VI Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Medipally against petitioner/respondent No.2.

2. Heard Mr. Bathini Upendar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1.

3. Though the criminal petition was filed seeking to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.59 of 2025, the learned counsel for the petitioner restricted his prayer requesting this Court to dispense with the appearance of the petitioner/respondent No.2 in D.V.C.No.59 of 2025, on the file of the II Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-VI Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Medipally, on the ground that the petitioner is eking out her livelihood by doing tailoring work. Hence, it is very difficult for the petitioner to appear on each and every date of adjournment in the Trial Court, as such the learned counsel sought for dispensing with the presence of petitioner before the Trial Court.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not opposed the submission made by the learned counsel for petitioner.

5. In view of the above submissions, and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the presence of the petitioner/respondent No.2 in D.V.C.No.59 of 2025, on the file of the II Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-VI Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Medipally, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that the petitioner/respondent No.2 shall be

represented by her counsel on every date of hearing, unless her presence is specifically required during the course of the trial. In the event of non-appearance of petitioner/respondent No.2 on any date so fixed by the trial Court, the trial Court shall be entitled to proceed with the matter in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, the criminal petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.

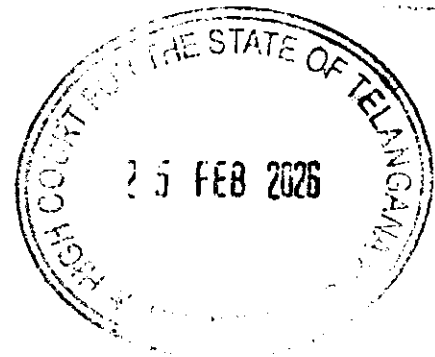
