Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent No.4 in not registering an FIR and in not issuing a Non-Traceable Certificate on the petitioner's complaints submitted through the Mee-Seva portal on 12-01-2026, and complaints dated 09-01-2026 and 16-01-2026, in respect of the missing original registered sale deed documents bearing Document No.466 of 2013 dated 18-01-2013 and Document No.467 of 2013 dated 18-01-2013, registered at S.R.O., Bodhan, as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, and violative of the principles of natural justice and consequently direct the respondents to register an FIR on the said complaints and issue a Non-Traceable Certificate in relation to the missing/lost documents.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent no.4 to take immediate steps for registering FIR pursuant to the complaint submitted by the Petitioner through mee leva portal on 12-01-2026 for missing of original Registered Sale deed and issue the no-traceable certificate regarding Document No.466 of 2013 and 467 of 2013 dt.18/01/2013 registered at S.R.O. Bodhan pending disposal of the above writ petition in the interest of justice.

**ORDER:**

This Writ Petition is filed seeking the following relief:-

“...to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of a writ of mandamus, declaring the action of respondent No.4 in not registering an F.I.R. and in not issuing a Non-Traceable Certificate on the petitioner’s complaints submitted through the Mee-Seva portal on 12.01.2026 and complaints dated 09.01.2026 and 16.01.2026 in respect of the missing original registered sale deeds bearing document Nos.466 of 2013 and 467 of 2013, dated 18.01.2013 registered as S.R.O., Bodhan, as illegal, arbitrary, unjust and

violative of the principles of natural justice and consequently, direct the respondents to register an F.I.R. on the said complaints and issue a Non-Traceable Certificate in relation to the missing/lost documents and to pass such..."

2. Heard Sri Ponnam Mahesh Babu, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri M.Srinivas, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home appearing for the respondents and with their consent, this writ petition is being taken up for disposal at the admission stage.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that, on 03.01.2026 at about 6:30 p.m. while the petitioner was proceeding to meet bankers at Gurbabadi Localiy, Nizamabad, he lost the original documents i.e., registered sale deeds bearing document Nos.466 and 467 of 2013, both dated 08.01.2013. Therefore, the petitioner made a detailed complaint, dated 09.01.2025 before respondent No.4 and he also submitted online application, dated 12.01.2026 through Meeseva *vide* acknowledgment No.15201201261809315302. The grievance of the petitioner is that, even after receipt of the aforesaid complaints, dated 09.01.2026 and 16.01.2026 the respondent-police did not issue a Non-Traceable Certificate.

4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home appearing for the respondents did not dispute the submission of the complaints, dated 09.01.2026 and 16.01.2026.

5. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on instructions, would submit that on receipt of the said complaint, dated 06.08.2025, respondent No.5 called the petitioner requiring him to produce the relevant and supporting documents for the purpose of conducting enquiry and taking further action on his complaint. Despite waiting for a period of nearly two months, the petitioner neither appeared before respondent No.5 nor produced any documents as called for. In view of the petitioner's non co-operation and failure to comply with the said requirement, his application was rejected on 09.10.2025 and the same was duly uploaded in Meeseva Portal. Therefore, he prays this Court to dismiss the writ petition.

6. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home and upon perusing the material on record and since the petitioner has already made the complaints, dated 09.01.2026 and 16.01.2026 before respondent No.4, this Court, without making any observations on the merits and demerits of the case, deems it

appropriate to dispose of this Writ petition to direct the petitioner to approach respondent No.4 along with the complaints, dated 09.01.2026 and 16.01.2026 and online Mee-seva application, dated 12.01.2026 including the required documents available with him to demonstrate that she lost the original sale deeds. In the event of petitioner's approach, respondent No.4 is directed to conduct enquiry and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

7. With the above observations, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, the miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.

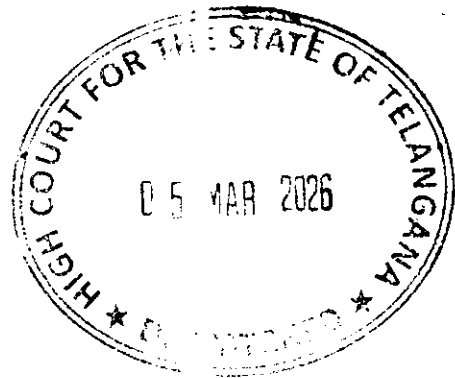
