Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inactions of the Respondents as being arbitrary, illegal and violative of Art 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequentially direct the Respondents to consider the representations of the petitioner forthwith and allot the identified Government land in Sy.No.199, Peerzadiguda Village, Medipally, Medchal-Malkajgiri District to an extent of Ac0-06gts for the construction of Brahmin Sadan/ Samithi for the welfare and common good of the community at large.

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue.

2. The petitioner - Abhaya Anjaneya Brahmana Seva Samithi, represented by its President, P. Seshagiri Rao, submitted an application dated 31.10.2022 requesting the respondent No.3 to allot Government land in an extent of 500 sq. yards to 1000 sq. yards in Sy.No.199, Medipally Village and Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, for construction of Brahmana Seva Samithi.

3. It appears from the record correspondence was exchanged by various officers of the Revenue Department and

Lr.No.LC/1478/20202 dated 05.02.2025 was addressed by the respondent No.3 - District Collector to respondent No.2 - Chief Commissioner of Land Administration wherein it is stated that the petitioner was directed to submit requisition before the concerned department as per G.O.Ms.No.571 Revenue (Assignment.I) Department dated 14.09.2012 in Annexure-XI/Checklist along with Appendix-XXIX for grant of State Government land from the concerned department and the same is awaited.

4. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner furnished copy of the Annexure-XI along with Proforma seeking allotment of Ac.0.06 guntas of land in Sy.No.199, Medipally Village, vide File No.LC/1478/2022. The same is taken on record.

5. In the light of the above submissions, the writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the application of the petitioner 31.10.2022 for allotment of Ac.0.06 guntas of land in Sy.No.199, Medipally Village and Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, within a period of sixty (60) days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

The miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

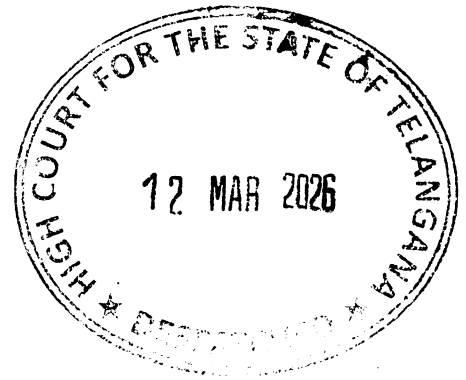
