WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate MS VEROSE SANJANA presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the criminal proceedings against the Petitioner herein i.e Accused herein in Crime No. 28 of 2026, PS Nizamabad VI Town, Nizamabad District, for the alleged offences Under Section. 308(6) BNS;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V. Rangunath, Senior Counsel representing for Ms Verose Sanjana Advocate for the Petitioner, Additional Public Prosecutor for Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 20.04.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings including arrest of the Petitioner/Accused herein in Crime No.28 of 2026, PS Nizamabad VI Town, Nizamabad District, for the alleged offences Under Section 308(6) BNS, pending disposal of CRLP No. 3065 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Mr. V. Ragnath, learned Senior Counsel representing Ms. Verose Sanjana, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence and he has been falsely implicated in the present case at the instance of respondent No.2 on the ground that the petitioner is running Bathukamma Digital Newspaper agency and had reported adverse news against police officials. Even according to the complaint, the alleged incident was occurred on 26.02.2025, however, after a lapse of more than 11 months, respondent No.2 lodged the complaint alleging that the petitioner demanded amount in order not to publish news against the swimming pool pertaining to respondent No.2 Respondent No.2 has not mentioned in the complaint as to when the petitioner allegedly demanded the said amount from him. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioner is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds, which were raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner, require detailed examination.

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

Post on 20.04.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused in Crime No.28 of 2026 of Nizamabad VI Town Police Station, Nizamabad District.

In default of filing proof of service by the next date of hearing, the interim stay granted shall stand vacated.
