WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI NAGESHWAR RAO PUJARI presented this Petition under Section 528 OF B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings against the petitioners/accused nos.4 and 6 in Crime No.667 of 2025 of P.S. Kushaiguda dated 08/09/2025 on the file of the II Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Kushaiguda. ✓

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.T.V.RAMANA RAO, learned counsel representing SRI NAGESHWAR RAO PUJARI Advocate for the Petitioners, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted. ✓

are directed to show cause on or before 06.04.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 OF B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the criminal petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused nos.4 and 6 in Crime No.667 of 2025 of P.S. Kushaiguda dated 08.09.2025 on the file of the II Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Medchal-Malkajiri District at Kushaiguda, pending disposal of the same.

**The Court made the following:
ORDER:**

Mr.T.V.Ramana Rao, learned counsel representing Mr.Nageshwar Rao Pujari, learned counsel for the petitioners, submitted that the petitioners have not committed the alleged offences and have been falsely implicated in the present crime as accused Nos.4 and 6 solely on the basis of the confession statement given by the co-accused. He further submitted that petitioner No.1/accused No.4 had discharged her services as counsel and had filed a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to accused No.2, vide CrI.M.P.No.506 of 2025 on the file of the IV Additional District and Sessions Judge, Medchal-Malkajiri District at Kushaiguda, and the said petition was dismissed on 24.10.2025. He further submitted that in the remand case diary, basing upon the confession statement given by the co-accused, it was alleged that the petitioners received an amount from the other accused and gave a false promise that they would secure bail and ensure that all the cases against accused Nos.1 and 2 would be closed. The said remand case diary was filed on 23.02.2026, whereas petitioner No.1/accused No.4 had filed the bail petition on behalf of accused No.2, in the month of October, 2025. The confession statement recorded by the Investigating

Officer is contrary to the orders passed by the learned Sessions Judge in CrI.M.P.No.506 of 2025 dated 24.10.2025. He further submitted that the alleged incident took place on 01.09.2025 and the crime was registered on 08.09.2025 after a lapse of more than seven days. The entire allegations are levelled only against the other accused. The petitioners, who merely discharged their duties as counsel, have been falsely implicated as accused Nos.4 and 6. Hence, the ingredients of Sections 316(5) and 318(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 are not attracted against the petitioners.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Post on 06.04.2026.

Till then, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.4 and 6 in Crime No.667 of 2025 of Kushaiguda Police Station, Hyderabad. In default of filing proof of service, the stay shall stand vacated.
