**: ORDER :**

This criminal revision case is filed by the petitioner aggrieved by the order dated 17.02.2026 passed in CrI.M.P.No.535 of 2025 in CrI.A.S.R.No.1137 of 2025 by the Principal Sessions Judge at Mahabubabad.

2. The petitioner filed the said petition under Rule 127 of Criminal Rules of Practice seeking to condone the delay of 180 days in filing the criminal appeal against the conviction and sentence passed by the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Thorrur in C.C.No.775 of 2024 on 01.04.2025. The trial Court after hearing both sides, dismissed the said petition stating that there is no plausible explanation offered by the accused for the said delay. Hence, this revision.
3. Heard Smt C.Vasundhara Reddy, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Sri M.Ramachandra Reddy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.
4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that it is a conviction appeal and accused is in jail. As there is no legal aid, he has not approached the appellate Court in time. He further contended that as this is conviction appeal, delay has to be condoned whereas the appellate Court has dismissed the said petition.
5. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and that the delay petition is filed by the accused who is in jail, this Criminal Revision Case is allowed

setting aside the order dated 17.02.2026 passed in CrI.M.P.No.535 of 2025 in CrI.A.S.R.No.1137 of 2025 by the Principal Sessions Judge at Mahabubabad, and the delay of 180 days in filing the criminal appeal is condoned. The appellate Court is directed to register the appeal.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.

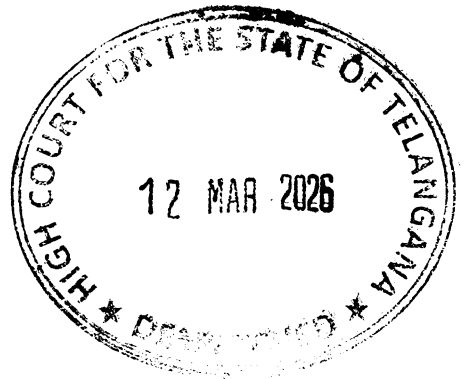
