WHEREAS the said case coming on for hearing, and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein, made the following;

**ORDER:**

**Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Kishore Kumar, learned counsel representing Mr. G. Madhusudhan Reddy, learned standing counsel for respondent No.2 – GHMC.**

**As it is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that proper precautions are not taken in the designated shelters maintained by GHMC and they are dumping dogs Animal Birth Control Centres instead of separate shelter homes. Even in Animal Birth Control Centres (ABCC) proper food and water are not provided to the dogs.**

**Hence, in order to have better information regarding facilities provided in the ABCC, Ms. P. Sree Ramya, Ms. Fareedunnisa Huma and Ms. K. Kiran Mayee, Advocates, are permitted**

to visit (i) Animal Care Centre, Fatullahguda, L.B. Nagar Zone, GHMC and (ii) Animal Care Centre at Patel Nagar, Azad Nagar, Amberpet, Khairatabad Zone, GHMC, on 28.02.2026 between 10 AM and 12 PM to inspect the centres and submit their report. The learned advocates are permitted to carry their mobile phones and take videos. However, the Advocates shall not cause any inconvenience to the dogs and persons taking care of dogs at the animal care centres. Further, it is made clear that no other person shall accompany the Advocates mentioned hereinabove.
