This Criminal Petition has been filed by the petitioner/complainant seeking a direction to the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Kamareddy, to dispose of C.F.R.No.1114 of 2022 in Crime No.255 of 2021 at the earliest, in the interest of justice.

2. Heard Mr. M. Mehdi Hussain, learned counsel for the petitioner, and Mr. Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner lodged a complaint before the Kamareddy Police Station, Kamareddy District, on 08.06.2021. Based on the said complaint, Crime No.255 of 2021 was registered against accused Nos.1 to 4 and others for the

offences punishable under Sections 420, 468 and 471 of the IPC. The Investigating Officer, without properly conducting the investigation, filed a final report referring the case as 'lack of evidence' before the Judicial First Class Magistrate, Kamareddy, on 30.03.2022. However, the learned Magistrate has not proceeded further in the matter till date.

5. Taking into consideration the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Kamareddy, is directed to take appropriate steps pursuant to the final report submitted by the Investigating Officer, dated 30.03.2022, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four (4) months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, the criminal petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.
