directing the 3rd and 4th respondents to survey the agricultural land in survey No.79/1B5 measuring an extent of 0-4.04 Hectares (Punja Land) Immedinayakanapalli Village, Shoolagiri Taluk, Krishnagiri District and consequently directing the 5th respondent to provide adequate police protection for the process of erecting fencing to mark the boundaries for the same by



considering petitioner representation dated 20.12.2025 within a stipulated period of time fixed by this Honourable Court.

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the respondents 3 and 4 to survey and demarcate the property, which according to the petitioner is owned by him, based on his representation dated 20.12.2025, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

2. The petitioner had submitted his representation 20.12.2025 for the aforesaid purpose. Since the same has not been considered till date, the petitioner has filed this writ petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions would submit that even though a prayer has been sought for in this writ petition to provide police protection for construction of a compound wall, the said prayer for the present is not pressed by the petitioner. The said undertaking given by the counsel for the petitioner on behalf of the petitioner is recorded.



4.Mr.S.Arumugam, learned Government Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents 1 to 4. Mr.Venkatatesa Perumal, learned Government **WEB COPY** Advocate (Crl.Side) accepts notice on behalf of the fifth respondent.

5.No prejudice will be caused to the respondents 3 and 4 if the said authorities are directed to survey and demarcate the boundaries of the petitioner's property, morefully described in the prayer to this writ petition, after hearing the objections if any from the neighbouring land owners as well as any other party whom they deem it fit. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of in the following manner:-

(a) Before surveying the lands in question, the respondents 3 and 4 are directed to issue notice to the neighbouring land owners and also to any other party, whom they deem it fit to put on notice.

(b) After receiving objections if any and after considering the same, the fourth respondent shall conduct survey and demarcate the boundaries of the property, morefully described in the prayer to this writ petition, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

(c) If the need arises for police assistance and on a request made by the fourth respondent, the fifth respondent



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shall render police assistance for the effective implementation
of this order.
