Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to SUSPEND the operation of the LOC Look Out Circular for a period of 1 year from 21.02.2026 to 20.02.2027, pending disposal of WP No. 5136 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of the above mentioned counsel,

The Court made the following;

ORDER:

This application is filed by the petitioner to suspend the operation of the Look Out Circular (LOC) for a period of one year i.e. from 21.02.2026 to 20.02.2027.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is required to travel out of India for a period of one year i.e. from 21.02.2026 to 20.02.2027 to visit United Kingdom, Dubai and Turkey in connection with the petitioner's business requirements, and therefore, prays this Court to suspend the LOC issued by respondent Nos.2 to 4 against the petitioner for the said period.

Learned Standing Counsel appearing for Respondent No. 4 submits that this Court had earlier, on 28.07.2025, suspended the LOC for a certain period by imposing certain conditions, and if the same conditions are imposed, he has no objection to the petitioner travelling for the aforesaid period.

Heard and perused the material on record.

A perusal of the proceeding sheet of this writ petition discloses that, on earlier occasion, the petitioner was granted permission to travel abroad subject to certain conditions, and there have been no complaints from the respondents that the petitioner has violated any of those conditions.

Further, though the I.A. has been filed seeking permission for the petitioner to travel to the United Kingdom, Dubai, and Turkey for a period of one year, this Court is inclined to grant permission only for the period from 24.02.2026 to 24.08.2026.

In that view of the matter, the petitioner is permitted to travel to United Kingdom, Dubai and Turkey from 24.02.2026 to 24.08.2026 subject to fulfilling the following conditions:-

- i. The petitioner shall provide necessary details with regard to petitioner's properties and bank accounts to respondent Nos.2 to 4.
- ii. The petitioner shall provide travel details including place of stay to respondent Nos.2 to 4.
- iii. The petitioner shall come back to Hyderabad and intimate such arrival to respondent Nos.2 to 4 on or before arrival to Hyderabad.
- iv. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions imposed in Crl.M.P.No.134 of 2025 in Crl.M.P.No. 159 of 2014 in C.C.No.7 of 2015 pending on the file of the learned Principal Special Judge for CBI Cases, Hyderabad.
- v. The petitioner shall file an affidavit in the form of an undertaking that the petitioner will abide by all the conditions mentioned above.
- vi. In case, if the petitioner failed to comply with his undertaking to come back to Hyderabad in the manner as directed above, the petitioner shall be liable to pay an amount of Rs.25,00,000/- in favor of respondent No.4.

It is made clear that on return, the petitioner shall deposit the passport before the Principal Special Judge for CBI Cases, Hyderabad in C.C. No.7 of 2015.

It is also made clear that only to the extent of orders passed by the Principal Special Judge for CBI Cases, Hyderabad and no objection reported by the Standing Counsel for respondent No.4, look out circular dated 25.02.2014 is suspended for a period from 24.02.2026 to 24.08.2026.

Accordingly, this application is disposed of.
