ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the 2nd respondent to conduct an enquiry and cancel the patta No.178 standing in the name of the 4th respondent by passing a final order on the petitioner's representation dated 19.12.2025, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

The petitioner had given a representation on 19.12.2025 to the 2nd respondent seeking to cancel the patta No.178 standing in the name of the 4th respondent for the property morefully described in the affidavit filed in support of this writ petition. Since the said representation was not considered, the petitioner has filed this writ petition.

3. Since no adverse order is being passed against the 4th respondent in this writ petition, notice to the 4th respondent is dispensed with in this writ petition.

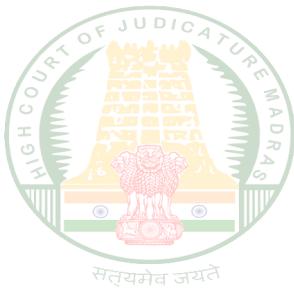
