Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Writ Petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No. 3 to forthwith undertake necessary medical tests of minor victim girl, who is the daughter of the Petitioner, by qualified surgeons, including Gynecologist / Obstetricians / Radiologists in presence of a qualified Physician with due care and precaution, so as to formulate an opinion in accordance with the Medical Termination of Pregnancy (Amendment) Act, 2021;

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case). The Court made the following

ORDER

Heard Ms. Zainab Khan, learned counsel for the petitioner, Ms. Swapna Madhuri, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Medical, Health and Family Welfare appearing for respondent Nos.1 and 3 and Mr.

M. Yadagiri, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Women Development and Child Welfare appearing for respondent No.2.

The application is filed to direct respondent No.3 to undertake necessary medical tests of minor victim girl who is the daughter of the petitioner, by qualified surgeons, including Gynecologist/Obstetrician/Radiologists and provide opinion in accordance with the Medical Termination of Pregnancy (Amendment) Act, 2021 about feasibility of carrying out abortion for the victim girl aged 15 years with foetus aged 25 weeks.

The abortion is sought as the minor girl is a victim of POCSO offence and both the mother and victim are not inclined to proceed with the pregnancy for a full term to deliver the child. In similar circumstances, this Court in W.P.No.17358 of 2024 directed respondent No.4 therein to constitute Medical Board and to submit report in a sealed cover within (24) hours. In similar circumstances in the instant case, the petitioner is also entitled the same relief.

The respondent No.3 - Superintendent, Gandhi Hospital is directed to immediately constitute a Medical Board and examine the victim with regard to gestation period of her foetus and feasibility to terminate her pregnancy, and submit a report to this Court by tomorrow i.e., 18.03.2026 at 2.30 P.M. in a sealed cover without fail.

Accordingly, this application is ordered.
