The Court made the following:**ORDER:**

The Writ Petition has been filed for the following relief:

“...to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declare the acts on the part of the respondents 2 and 3 in non extending Police help to the petitioner pursuant to the representation dated 22.1.2026 by duly implementing the orders passed in IA No. 626/2025 in OS No. 1096/2025 dated 17.12.2025 on the file of Honble III Addl. Civil judge (Junior Division) Rajamahendravaram, East Godavari District amounts to erroneous, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India besides being violative of various expressions expressed by this Honble Court and consequently direct the respondents 2 and 3 to extend the Police help to the petitioner as and when necessary for the properties as referred in the plaint in OS No. 1096/2025 on the file of Honble III Addl. Civil judge (Junior Division) Rajamahendravaram, East Godavari District in the interest of justice...”

2. Heard learned counsel for Petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader.

3. Mr.T.C.Krishnan, learned counsel for Petitioner, submits that the Petitioner has submitted a representation dated 22.01.2026 requesting the Respondent Nos.2 and 3 to implement the order in I.A. No. 626 of 2025 passed in O.S. No. 1096 of 2025, dated 17.12.2025, by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Rajamahendravaram, East Godavari District (for brevity, ‘the learned Trial Court’).

4. *Per contra*, Sri P.Ajay Babu, learned Assistant Government Pleader, on written instructions, submits that based on the complaint lodged by the petitioner, a case in Crime No.401 of 2025 under Sections 329(1), 324(1),

351(2), 296 and 115(1) read with 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity, 'the BNS') has been registered and they have investigated into the case.

5. The learned counsel for Petitioner further submits that even after registration of the said crime, the Respondents and their henchmen have been interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the Petitioner.

6. On perusal of the record, the orders of 'the learned Trial Court' have not come to the rescue of the Petitioner. Indeed, the representation dated 22.01.2026 submitted by the Petitioner is still pending with the Respondent/Police. Therefore, there shall be a direction to the Respondent/Police to consider the said representation in accordance with law.

7. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending, shall stand closed.
