The Court made the following:

ORDER:

The Writ Petition has been filed for the following relief:

“...to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the arbitrary and illegal action of the Respondent No.4 in interfering with the civil dispute upon the instigation of the Respondents No.5 to 7, while pending the Civil Suit O.S.No.23 of 2026 on the file of the Court of the Civil Judge (Junior Division) at Kanigiri, filed by the petitioners herein and threatening them as they will foist criminal cases against the petitioners if they will not leave from the suit schedule land of the petitioners an extent of Ac. 13.47 Cents in Sy.No.76/ 1 of Bodavuladinne Village, C.S. Puram Mandal, Markapuram District is as arbitrary, illegal, unjust, unconstitutional and against the principles of natural justice, consequently, directing the respondents not to interfere with the dispute of the suit schedule property...”

2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the learned Assistant Government Pleader.

3. The learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that Respondent No.4, at the behest of Respondents No.5 to 7, is interfering in the civil dispute between the Petitioners and the unofficial Respondents, which is pending in O.S. No.23 of 2026 before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kanigiri, and is threatening to foist criminal cases against the Petitioners.

4. Sri P. Ajay Babu, learned Assistant Government Pleader, on written instructions, submits that Respondent No.4 only acted to maintain peace and public order during the altercation on 24.02.2026. He states that the police merely dispersed the parties and advised them to pursue remedies before the learned Civil Court.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and recording the submissions of the learned Assistant Government Pleader, the Writ Petition is disposed of, directing the Respondent No.4 not to interfere henceforth in the civil dispute between the Petitioners and the Respondent Nos.5 to 7 without following due process of law.

6. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
