WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI VEERA SAVAN CHAKRAVARTHY DARA presented this Petition under Section 528 OF B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the DVC No. 95 of 2024, on the file IXth Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Kukatpally, Cyberabad (TS), against the Petitioner Nos.1 to 3, in the interest of justice and fair play.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI VEERA SAVAN CHAKRAVARTHY DARA Advocate for the Petitioners, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 11.08.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

IA NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 OF B.N.S.S., praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the criminal petition the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings against the Petitioners in the DVC No. 95 of 2024 on the file IXth Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Kukatpally, Cyberabad (TS), Pending the above Criminal Petition in the interest of justice.

ORDER:**

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Sri Veera Savan Chakravarthy Dara, learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that respondent No.2 filed D.V.C. No.95 of 2024 on the file of the learned IX Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, Ranga Reddy District at Kukatpally, impleading the petitioners as party respondents and claiming various reliefs under the provisions of the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 by making omnibus allegations. He further submits that the very same allegations are levelled against the petitioners in C.C.No.2788 of 2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. The petitioners and others approached this Court by filing Crl.P.No.15778 of 2024 seeking quashing of the proceedings in

C.C.No.2788 of 2024 on the file of the IX Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Kukatpally. This Court, by order dated 17.10.2025, allowed the said criminal petition in part, quashing the proceedings insofar as accused Nos.2 to 7 therein, and petitioner Nos.2 and 3 herein were arrayed as accused Nos.2 and 3 in the said C.C. By virtue of the quashing of the proceedings against petitioner Nos.2 and 3 in Crl.P.No.15778 of 2024, continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners in D.V.C. No.95 of 2024 is a clear abuse of the process of law.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid submissions, there is force in the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, and a detailed examination is required.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against petitioner Nos.2 and 3 in D.V.C.No.95 of 2024 on the file of the learned IX Additional Metropolitan Magistrate at Kukatpally, Cyberabad (TS).
