The Court made the following:**ORDER:**

This Criminal Petition under Sections 480 and 482 of BNSS, 2023, seeking to enlarge the Petitioner/A.1 on bail in connection with Crime No.62 of 2025 of Rolugunta Police Station Anakapalli District.

Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and Ms.K.Priyanka Lakshmi, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for respondent State. Perused the material on record.

Learned counsel for the Petitioner would submit that petitioner herein is arrayed as A.1 in the subject crime and that no specific allegations attributed against him attracting the offences lodged against him and that statutory period is completed and charge sheet is not filed by the respondent Police. Learned counsel would submit that the investigating agency filed a petition seeking extension of time to complete the investigation which was dismissed on 30.01.2026. The Petitioner has been in Jail since 27.07.2025 and that the Petitioner is entitled for statutory bail. Learned counsel requested to enlarge him on bail.

Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor fairly conceded to the submissions of learned counsel for the Petitioner and would submit that the statutory period is completed and no charge sheet is filed. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor would submit that the contraband involved is 60 kgs. and necessary conditions may be imposed while passing appropriate orders.

Considering the submissions made, this Criminal Petition is allowed. The Petitioner/A.1 shall be released on regular bail with the following conditions:

- a) Petitioner shall execute a personal bond for Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
 - b) Petitioner shall appear before the investigating agency once in a week i.e, on every Sunday between 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. until further orders.
 - c) Petitioner shall appear before the investigating agency as and when required till completion of investigation and shall co-operate with the investigating agency.
 - d) Petitioner shall deposit his passport if any before the Special Court. He shall not leave the country without permission of the Court.
- Pending applications, if any, shall stands closed.
