Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ order or direction more in the nature of Mandamus, declare the action of the respondents in seizing the Mahindra Bolero Pick Up Goods Carriage vehicle bearing No. TS-15-UE-7780 Chasis No. MA1ZU2TNKN1H78242 of the Petitioner without following any procedure laid down under policy decision taken by the government and in terms of G.O.Ms.No.15, Industries & Commerce (Mines-I) Department, dated 19-02-2015 as being illegal arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and violative of Articles 14, 16, 19 (1)(g), 21, 300-A and 301 of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to release the Mahindra Bolero Pick Up Goods Carriage vehicle bearing No. TS-15-UE-7780 Chasis No. MA1ZU2TNKN1H78242 of the Petitioner, forthwith.

ORDER : (ORAL)

Heard Mr. V.Yadu Krishna Sainath, learned counsel for the petitioner; Mr. K.Gautham Reddy, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Mines and Geology, appearing for respondents No.1 and 4; learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, appearing for respondent No.2; Mr. L.Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, appearing for respondent No.3; and perused the material on record.

2. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home submitted that the vehicle of the petitioner bearing Registration No.TS15 UE 7780 was seized in connection with F.I.R. No.244 of 2025 dated 07.10.2025 registered with Chinnakodur Police Station, under Sections 303(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS) and 3(1) of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984. Due to the bandobast for the on-going municipal elections, respondent No.2 was not in a position to deposit the vehicle before the concerned Court. Learned Assistant

Government Pleader submitted that the vehicle will be deposited before the concerned Court on or before 16.02.2026.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in similar circumstances, the order dated 11.02.2026 was passed by this Court in W.P. No.4167 of 2026 and requested same order to be passed in this writ petition. The said submission is not opposed by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Mines and Geology and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home.

4. In the circumstances, this writ petition is disposed of in terms of the order dated 11.02.2026 passed by this Court in W.P. No.4167 of 2026. Respondent No.2 is directed to deposit the vehicle of the petitioner bearing Registration No.TS15 UE 7780 before the concerned Court. On such deposit, the petitioner shall file application under Section 503 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) or any other appropriate provision for release of the vehicle. As and when such application is filed, the same shall be disposed of by the concerned Court, within a period of three (3) days thereafter. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in this writ petition, stand closed.

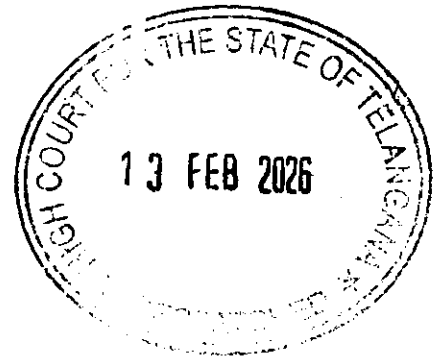
